[APPLICATIONS]

For flow cytometry, the suggested use of this reagent is 1 µg per 10⁶ cells in 100 µl volume.

Optimal working dilutions could be determined by end user.

[FORMULATION]

Form & Buffer: Supplied as solution form in 10 mM Tris, 150 mM NaCl, pH 8.2 , 50% glycerol , 0.05% Proclin-300.

[STORAGE AND STABILITY]

Storage: Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Keep in Dark Place

Store at 4°C for frequent use.

Aliquot and store at -20°C for 12 months.

Stability Test: The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.

Note: As fluorescence can photobleach when exposed to light, so the antibody must be protected from light.
